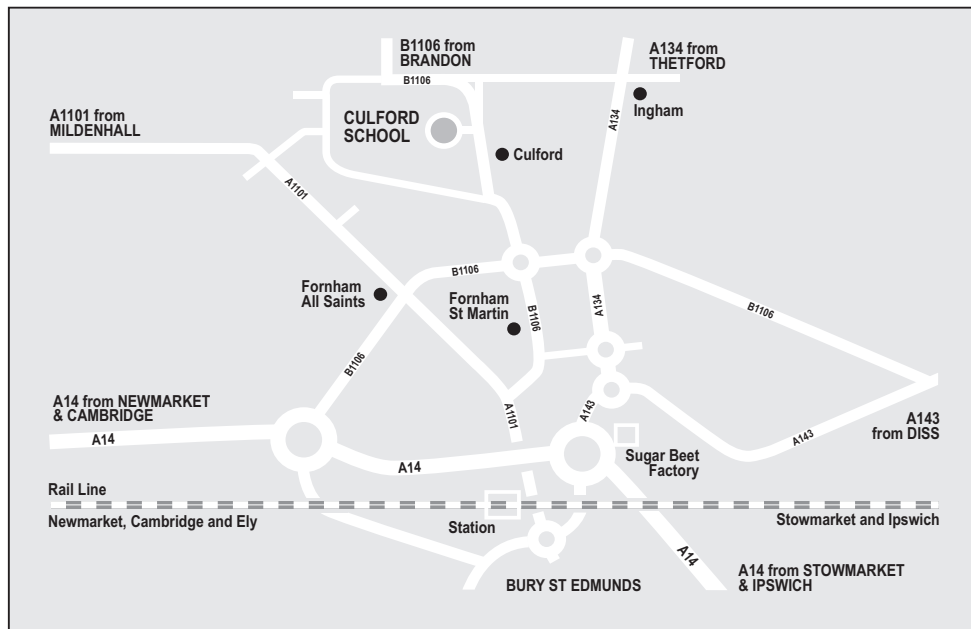

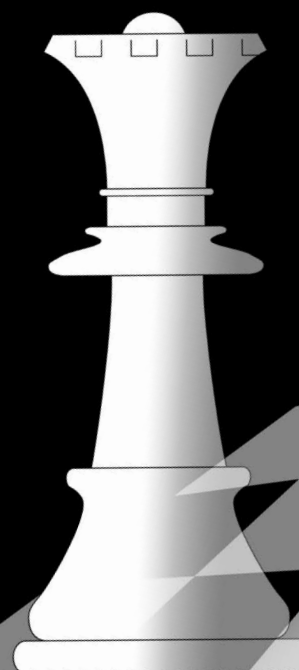

SPECIAL OFFER

Five for the price of four!

If five players enter from the same school, you need only pay for four. This offer only applies when the school co-ordinates entries and sends one cheque to cover their entries. Multiples also apply, so if ten pupils enter from the same school, two will be free.

There will be a free-to-enter Team Competition, open only to bona fide pupils from the same school (teams of five). They can be entered in any section.



The Bury Knights Junior Chess Club was formed in September 1992 and meets every Friday at Horringer Court Middle School, Glastonbury Road, from 6.00 to 8.00 pm.

The event sees the return of the Bury Junior Congress, after a gap of six years (last held in 1999).

SECTIONS

The event will be divided into five sections by age, with a further section for parents, grandparents or guardians of entrants. Ages are as at 1 September 2006, so if your 12th birthday was on 24 September 2006, you can still enter the u12 section.

Adults can play in the 'Parents' section if their child is entered in one of the age-group sections.

ENTRY FEES

The entry fee for all Junior sections is £6.00 (equivalent to £1.00 per game). ECF Members may deduct £0.72 (= £5.28.) Entry to the Parents' section is FREE.

RATE OF PLAY/CLOCKS

The rate of play for all sections will be 30 minutes per player per game. Clocks will be used in all sections and assistance will be given to any player unused to handling them.

BYES

Players may request a HALF-POINT BYE in the first round only, if travelling to the event for an 09.30 start causes a problem. Otherwise, entrants will play in all rounds (Swiss System). It is NOT a knockout event.

GRAND PRIX

This event will qualify for the English Chess Federation Grand Prix (Junior Section). All members of the ECF are entitled to compete for Grand Prix points.

CLOSING DATE

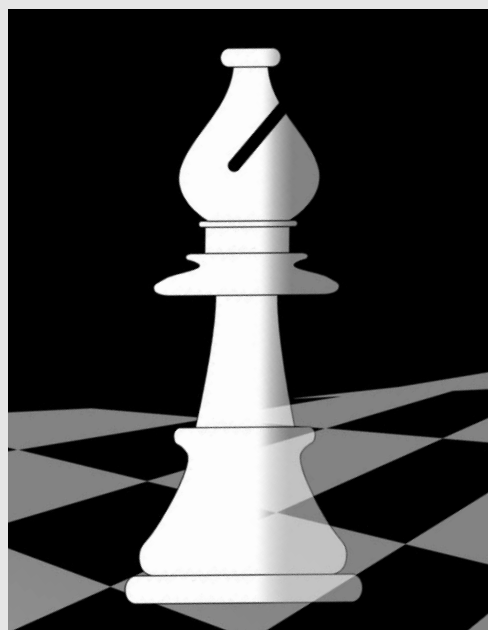
Entries will be accepted if postmarked by Wednesday 21 February at the latest. Acceptance thereafter will depend on availability of space and payment of a £4.00 late entry fee.

PRIZES

FIRST PRIZE in all junior sections will be £60.00, with other cash prizes being awarded according to size of entry. Junior section winners will also receive trophies. The parents section is 'just for fun'.

GRADING

All results will be submitted to the English Chess Federation for their Rapidplay Grading List.



REFRESHMENTS

Light refreshments will be available throughout the event. Players may bring and consume packed lunches in the school.

BOOKSTALL

A bookstall will be provided by Peter Keffler. A good range of books and chess equipment will be available throughout the day.
